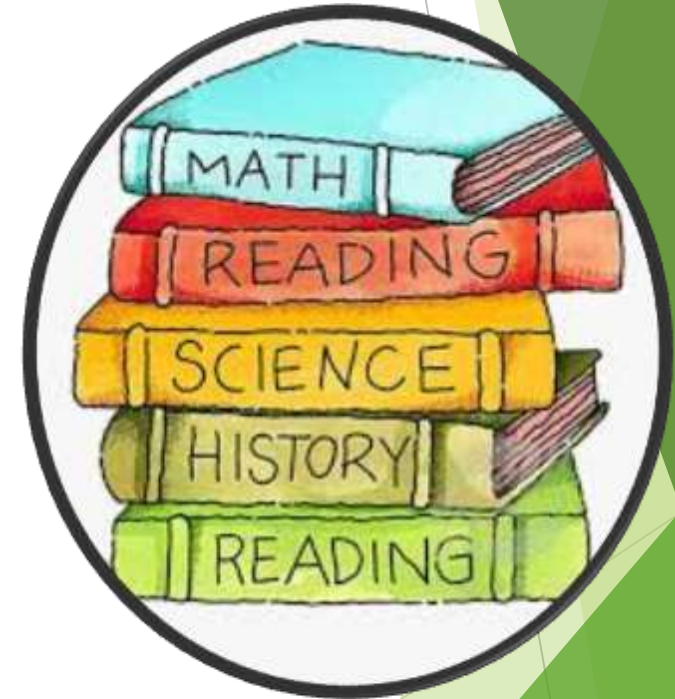

PASSING CRITERIA (IX & X)

- ▶ There will be **3** Periodic Tests conducted through out the year. At the end of the year an average of **best of 2** periodic tests will be considered for internal marks.
- ▶ **35** marks out of 100 is **passing** per subject.
- ▶ Grade 9 and Grade 10 prelims it is compulsory to secure 35 marks in each subject.

MATHEMATICS – Grade X

- ▶ **BASIC MATHS** – Those who wish to opt for exams other than JEE and NEET (Board questions from NCERT textbook only.)
- ▶ **ADVANCE MATHS** – Compulsory for NEET & JEE. (Board Questions will be based on analytical, critical and higher thinking order.)
